## **St. Thomas Aquinas Young Adults Cruise**

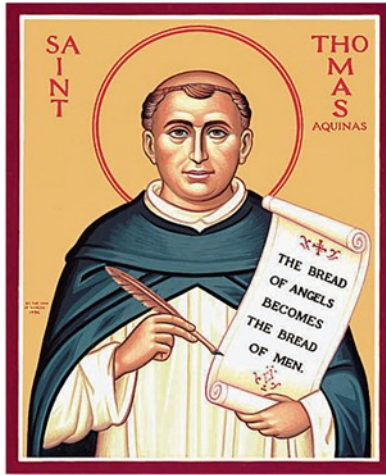
