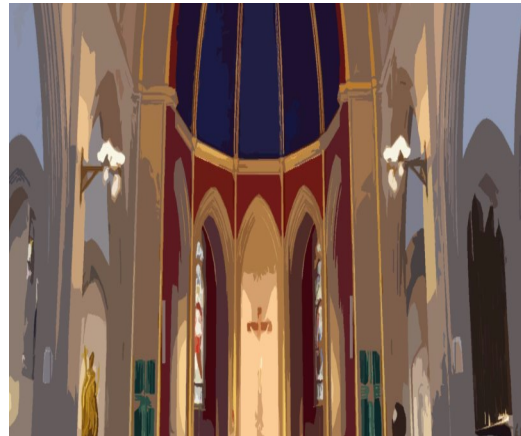
St. Thomas Aquinas Bereavement Group
