## **ST. THOMAS AQUINAS FAITH FORMATION**

The Faith Formation of our children continues through the full reception of all the Sacraments of Initiation – Baptism, First Eucharist and Confirmation. In order to ensure the process of the faith formation journey of our children, it is necessary to re-register them each year.

We are currently accepting registration for the 2018-2019 school year. All Re-Registrations and New Registrations for the On-Site program and for the On-Line MyCatholicFaithDelivered (3<sup>rd</sup> through 6<sup>th</sup> grade) program will receive a \$25 reduction in the total fee if registration is completed by June 30. Registration will continue throughout the summer.
