## RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

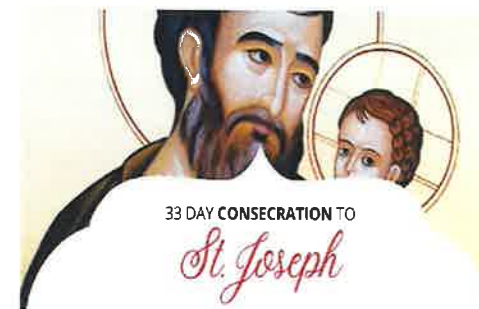
