Religious Education for 2021-2022 year is currently underway. Please contact the Rectory for more information.

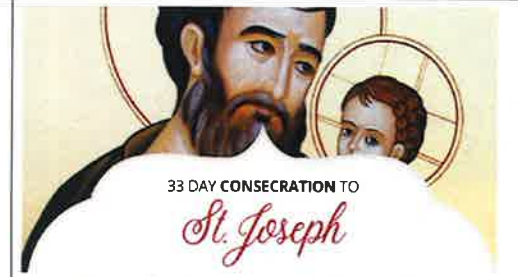

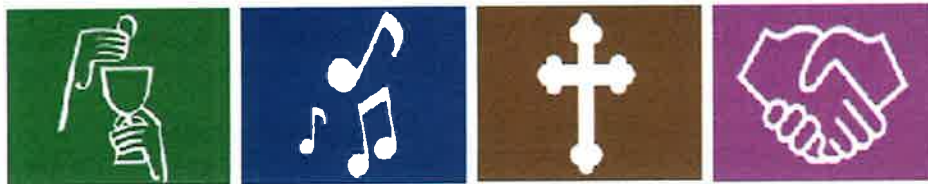
- United in worshipping the Father, The Son, and the Holy Spirit by serving Him through serving one another.*
