### **COMMUNION TO THE HOMEBOUND**

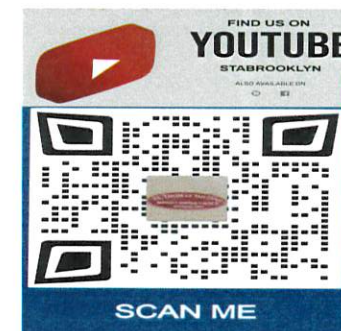

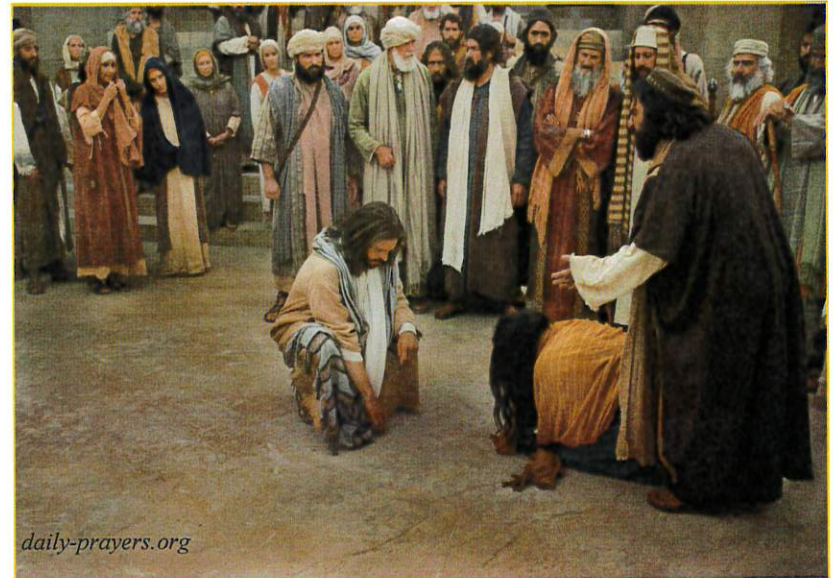
