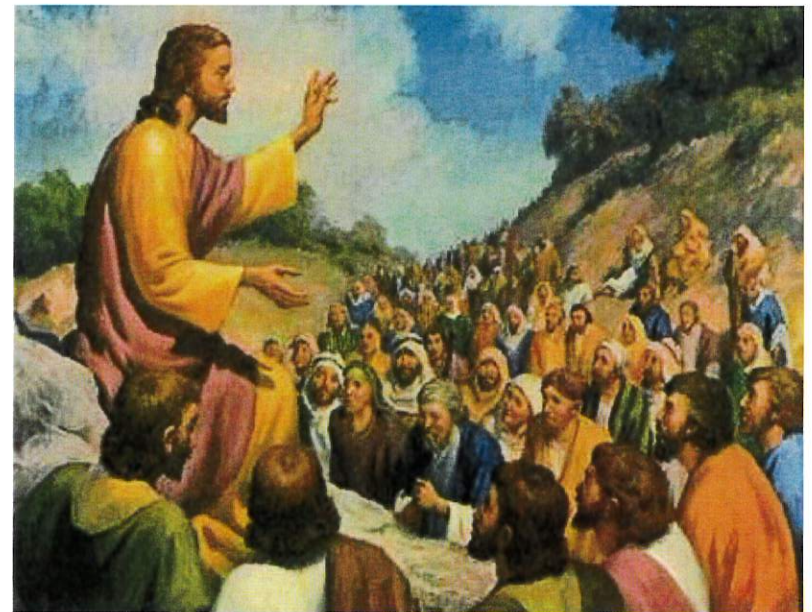

Parish Mission Statement

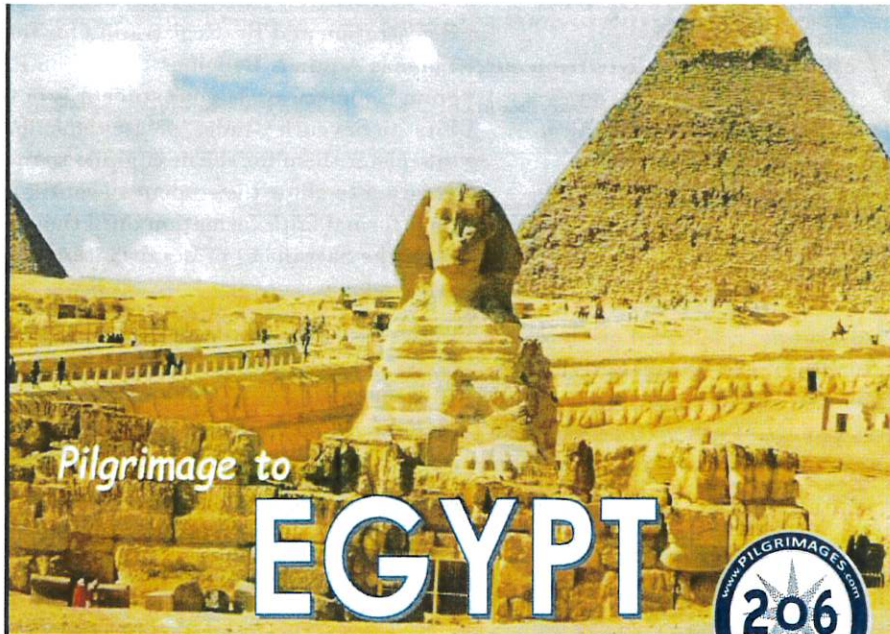

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION 2022-2023

Registration and Re-Registration for the St. Thomas Aquinas Religious Education Program is underway.
